

We, at the Wayne Transportation Department are glad to have the opportunity to talk to your students/children about the importance of school bus safety. School buses are one of the safest forms of transportation, but unfortunately every year children are injured across the country in school bus accidents.

Education is the key to prevention. School bus drivers are required to retest and retrain every four years in order to maintain their certification. This is a public awareness campaign to educate the students, teachers, as well as parents about the importance of School Bus Safety.


We need your help to educate the children on the basic school bus safety rules. Please take some time to speak to your students/children about the following school bus safety rules:

- 1. Be on time.
- 2. Never run to or from the bus.
- Stand back from the curb.
- 4. Don't push or shove.
- 5. Stay in your seat.
- 6. Don't yell or shout.
- 7. Always obey the driver.
- 8. Always cross at least 10 feet in front of the bus.
- 9. Never crawl under a school bus.




Commect the Dots




ALWAYS OBEY THE CROSSING GUARD




In the afternoon when school is over, our teacher helps us to find the right bus to go home.


Safety tip: Look for your bus number to be sure you're boarding the right bus.




Intersection Mania: Counting signs

Safety tip: Walk around the yellow bar so the bus driver can see you.






Carmen's older sister, Rosa, attends the high school next door. Sometimes she wants to drive Carmen to school, but Carmen would rather ride the bus with her friends.


Safety tip: Always take the bus. It's the safest way to get to school.
