Delayed Openings, Minimal Days, and Emergency Early Dismissals

Our primary concern is the safety and security of approximately 7,650 students and 1,450 employees in our 15 schools. Shown below is a schedule of pre-determined times for Delayed Openings, Emergency Early Dismissals, and Minimal Days. The Superintendent makes the decision to close schools, delay the opening due to inclement weather or any other reason as early as possible.

* ^ **Minimal Day & Emergency Dismissal:** Students who walk to school will be dismissed to go home, provided that conditions are safe for them to leave their school building.

Bus Students:

❖ **Delayed Opening Bus Schedule:** Pick up times at all bus stops will be 90 minutes later on delayed opening days.

^ **Emergency Early Dismissal:** Students will be supervised by staff until such time transportation can be provided.
