Overnight Field Trip Information**

A School Nurse will be attending your child's field trip on May 15-17, 2019
to Washington, DC.

According to NJ State Department of Education (NJAC 6A:16-2.1), the administration of medication to students may **ONLY** be provided by: (1) A Wayne Board of Education school physician, (2) A school district employed school nurse, or (3) The student's parent/guardian.

Students who need asthma inhalers and/or Epipens may carry and self administer if the complete and accurate medical documentation is provided to the nurse (NJSA 18A:40-12.3 and 12.4)

NO student may carry or take medications. NO chaperone is permitted to carry or administer any medication to students. A parent/guardian may ONLY give medication to his/her OWN child. The nurse attending the trip will carry and administer any needed medications.

Please check the appropriate line and sign below, allowing the nurse permission to give the following medications as needed. The nurse will provide the following:

For minor discomforts


_____ Benadryl – 25 mg, 1 Or 2 tablets

For minor allergic reactions


