Project Graduation is a drug and alcohol free, chaperoned celebration following your child's graduation ceremonies from Wayne Valley High School. PTO Guidelines state that in order to participate in Project Graduation event, a student must have his/her commitment fees PAID IN FULL. The Project Graduation commitment fee is \$180.00 which can either be paid in full or three installments of \$60.00 per Sophomore, Junior & Senior year. Any financial need can be addressed through the school nurse. **These fees are separate from PTO dues and class dues that you may have already paid to the school through Community Pass.** Project Graduation fees must be paid in full in order to participate in the Fashion Show Fundraiser in Senior year.
