

**STUDENT COVID NOTIFICATION COMMITMENT
 2021-2022**

By acknowledging this waiver, for the period of September 1, 2021 to June 30, 2022, I am attesting that if my student exhibits any of the following symptoms, he/she will not attend school or extracurricular activities that day or as long as the symptoms persist and the School Nurse should be notified.

Fever or chills	Fatigue, muscle, or body aches	Sore throat	Nausea, vomiting, diarrhea
Cough	New loss of taste or smell	Headache, congestion, or runny nose	Difficulty breathing, or shortness of breath

I also understand a negative COVID-19 test may be necessary for my student to return to school. Any updated guidance from the CDC, NJDOH or WDOH will be shared as appropriate.

If your student has a chronic condition and is exhibiting any of the symptoms above, please contact your School Nurse for guidance.

In addition, if any of the categories in the chart below apply to my student, I also attest that my student will not come to school or attend any extracurricular activities during the required time period.

***Fully vaccinated students who have traveled outside of the USA should seek guidance from the school nurse before returning to school. This statement does not apply to any student who has been diagnosed with COVID-19 in the past 3 months, and who is not showing symptoms.*
