GET TO KNOW US

Born out of necessity, the Wayne Township Memorial First Aid Squad has grown to become an efficient organization responding to thousands of emergency calls each year. In 1942 Wayne Township suffered 8 deaths during a bitterly cold week in February. Ambulance service was then provided by neighboring towns. A group of concerned citizens, seeing the need, took it upon themselves to start a local ambulance squad. The Squad was officially incorporated in 1943.

The organization that started out with a handful of members has now grown to over 65 Emergency Medical Technicians (EMTs). Women were made a part of the Squad in 1968 and they have been a vital part of the Squad ever since. A Youth Squad was established in 1973 enabling young people between the ages of 16 and 18 to become members of the Squad. Many of the Youth continue to become Active Members of the Squad.
