No pupil in twelfth grade may leave the school building and/or school grounds during lunch unless the Board approved permission slip, which includes a waiver of all Board of Education liability, is signed by the pupil's parent(s) or legal guardian(s) or the adult pupil and is on file with the administration of the pupil's school.

Any pupil who leaves the school building and/or school grounds during lunch without authorization will be subject to disciplinary action.

5515- OPEN LUNCH PERIOD

Open lunch period for twelfth grade pupils is a <u>senior</u> privilege at each high school. Seniors are allowed to leave the school building and/or school grounds during his/her assigned lunch time. Students are expected to follow all Board policies, regulations and rules, including all rules and regulations as outlined in the student handbook. Students who drive and park on school property must also follow the Board's policies, regulations and rules concerning parking on school property.

Each senior must return the attached permission slip which states that they are aware of the open lunch policy and procedures and the consequences of failing to comply with these expectations. This signed permission slip must be on file with the administration of the pupil's school before the pupil may leave the school building and/or school grounds.

Expectations:

- 1. Seniors may only leave during their assigned lunch time. Seniors must display their ID cards at all times.
- 2. Seniors must sign out and sign in on the sign in sheet at the main office of their school.
- 3. Seniors must exit and enter their school building through the main front doors only.
- 4. Seniors who are scheduled to a class following their assigned lunch time must be back to class on time.
- 5. Seniors may not transport underclass pupils.
- 6. Any community concerns related to this senior privilege may result in the loss of the privilege.
- 7. Any senior who does not follow the Board policies and regulations, or fails to comply with other school expectations, may have his/her privilege taken away. **Leaving school grounds during open lunch is a privilege NOT a right.**
- 8. The administration reserves the right to disallow seniors to leave campus due to inclement weather.

Consequences:

- 1. Any pupil who is late to a class following lunch, or commits a minor infraction during lunch time, may be assigned to lunch detention for one day.
- 2. If the pupil commits a second offense, he/she may be assigned to lunch detention for one week.
- 3. If the pupil commits a third offense, he/she may be assigned to lunch detention for a month and/or may lose lunch privileges for the remainder of the school year.
- 4. Loss of the open lunch privilege may require the student to eat in lunch detention each day.

5.	Any senior transporting an underclassman off school property will be assigned lunch detention for the remainder of the school year and may also risk losing their parking permit.
